

How to support your child in Year 8 RE	
General	When supporting your child with their home learning, please refer to the notes that they will have made in lesson in their pink notebooks. All of the content of the lessons will be in those books. They will have all assessments stuck into their books so you can see how they are working in RE. Looking at their strengths and next steps can help you to know how they can improve their work. Students will also have a knowledge organizer stuck into their book which will give you key terms and knowledge they need to know. To support your child further, you can talk through this information and test them on their spelling or knowledge of the key ideas.
