

School Transport End of Term Message for Parents and Carers

The School Transport Team has helped transport over 3800 children from home to school and college this academic year.

The team are now busy ensuring that transport arrangements are in place again for the start of the new academic year.

Once contractual arrangements are confirmed with the bus and taxi providers the team will then start to send out the new bus passes for September 2024 for those who need them.

- The Transport Team can only offer spare seat availability at the beginning of September once all eligible students have been allocated to a route and where there are no other public transport services in place. The cost of a spare seat for 2023/24 is £460 for the full year.
