



Students can select any subject but you must achieve the entry requirement.

All courses run for two years apart from the Traineeship which is one year.

All students have three subject choices (some students may follow four often by choosing further Maths).

All applicants have a guidance meeting with a member of the Sixth Form team to discuss the suitability of their option choices.
