Beyond the classroom

Beyond the classroom students are encouraged to undertake additional responsibilities as part of the Head Student and Sixth Form Ambassador Team. They are actively involved in our Maximising Achievement Team, supporting students in the lower school through peer mentoring, running workshops to help with target setting. Students work with Main School students to share tips on how to perform well in exams, as well as running revision skills sessions for parents. The Sport and Societies programme allows for students to participate or even lead an extra-curricular activity area, with thriving societies including debate, future medics, baking, journalism and a multitude of sports. When entering into Year 12 students have the opportunity to complete the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), developing the skills required for higher education whilst completing research with a focus of their choosing.
