

Catch Up Premium Statement 2019-20

What is Catch Up Premium?

Catch Up Premium is additional funding that is provided to schools to support Year 7 students who were significantly below their peers in their Key Stage 2 SATs data in reading and/or maths. Its purpose is to boost students' literacy and/or numeracy skills with a target of 'catching up' with their peers. We were allocated £17,921 for the 2019-2020 cohort and had a carry forward of £3,214 from 2018-2019, totalling £21,135.

What was the impact in the Maths cohort of 11 Year 7 students?

In Maths 18% made 'good' progress, based on data taken in March 2020. This means that 18% of these students were in line with their 'good progress bands' at the end of the year, which are set at the top 50% of all students nationally based on their individual starting points.

What was the impact in the English cohort of 19 Year 7 students?

In English 63% made 'good' progress or better, based on data taken in March 2020. This means that 63% of these students were in line with their 'good progress bands' at the end of the year, which are set at the top 50% of all students nationally based on their individual starting points.

In addition, significant progress was made in reading and spelling. The below demonstrates progress within a 6 months testing period.
