Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award 2022

We are delighted to welcome and enrol your son / daughter onto the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE). Within this letter you will find a breakdown of how the Bronze award works, and the next steps in terms of enrolment and payment.

How it works

There are three levels to the Award – Bronze, Silver and Gold. To achieve their **Bronze Award**, students will need to complete four sections – **Volunteering**, **Physical**, **Skills** and the Expedition. Students can choose what they would like to do for the first three sections, and we will provide all the guidance and support they need, each of these sections lasts 3 months. The Expedition involves spending two days and one night in the countryside. We provide comprehensive training beforehand to ensure everyone is fully prepared and has the best possible experience. Training Expedition will be on the **21**st **May – 22**nd **May 2022** Assessed Expedition will be on the **9**th **July – 10**th **July 2022**.

Payment Schedule

The cost for the Bronze award is £200 per student – the payment will be split across three deadlines from January to June. All payments must be paid via ParentPay. - I agree to my son / daughter receiving emergency medical treatment, including anaesthetic, as considered necessary by the medical authorities present.
- I understand the school has taken out insurance cover on each child participating on the trip.

Refund and Payment Liability Information

Please understand that your child's place is subject to good behaviour over the forthcoming year and they will be required to adhere to the schools BfL policy. The school's management reserves the right to withdraw students from activities for disciplinary reasons and, in these circumstances, no refund will be given.

Should you choose to withdraw your child from their Dof E Award, no refund will be available for the Welcome Pack and you will be liable to continue making payments as per the payment schedule on page 1 of this letter and any cancellation fees incurred.

Due to the nature of the DofE Award, your child's place cannot be taken up by another student. Students must complete and pay for both the Training and Assessed Expeditions, alongside the 3 other sections to complete their DofE award and receive their DofE certificate.
